Chandranahan Lake Trek is in the south-eastern slopes of the Himalayas. Located in the Rohru town in Shimla district of Himachal Pradesh. Chandranahan Lake is not just the trekking place, rather it has spiritual importance in Rohru. As per the regional belief, it is the birth place of Devta Shikru Naharaj (God), and followers believe that once in every ten years Moon (Chandra Maa) visits the lake for a ritual bath. So on the name of Chandra i.e Chand (Moon) this name had given name Chandranahan.

It is believed that there are 7 lakes but only 6 lakes are visible to us but the seventh lake is one of mightiest lake among them but till today no one had ever seen this lake. So this trek also gives trekkers some thrilling moments during the trek. Local people believes that lake is a holy home of Goddess Kali and one of the mightiest Lord Jakh.

The alluring temple of Devta Jakh is located in the heart of Rohru in Janglikh village. The temple is nearly 500 years old and its architecture and design are some of the attractive things for the travelers and trekkers. Before entering this historic place Janglikh, firstly you will be welcomed by a mesmerizing water fall of approximately 50metets truly a treat for eyes.

The altitude of Chandranahan trek takes you to around 4200 meters above sea level and definitely it takes you on the peak of thrill and advantage. This is one of most beautiful trekking routes of the region. Chandranahan Lake Trek is truly mesmerizing. It is the trekkers paradise, has everything right from the Sky kissing mountains, deep virgin forests to gurgling streams, waterfalls after every 5km of trek which leave travelers spellbind. The trek starts from the heritage and historic Janglikh Village.

Program Itinerary :

Day 01 Surat to Chandigarh by 3AC Train

Day 02 Reach Chandigarh, Depart to Kufri by Tempo Traveler, Night stay in hotel (4 Sharing)

Day 03 Kufri to Janglikh Village Home stay (9,200 ft.) drive around 130 Kms, 4-5 Hrs.

Day 04 Janglikh to Dayara Thach (11,150 ft.) Trek 7.5 kms, 5-6 Hrs.

Day 05 Dayara thach to Litham Thach (11,800 ft.) trek 5 Kms, 3-4 Hrs.

Day 06 Excursion of Chandranahan than back to Litham Thach or

Day 07 Dayara thach. Trek Around 4 Kms., 5-6 Hrs.

Day 08 Litham Thach to janglikh village. Trek 9 to 10 kms, 6-8 Hrs.

Janglikh to Shimla hotel stay. drive around 130 Kms, 6 Hrs.

Day 09 By Late evening in Shimla. Overnight Journey to Delhi by Volvo.

Day 10 Early Morning arrival at Delhi. Fresh up at Delhi. In evening depart for Surat.

Day 11 Reach Surat by 3 AC Train with happy memories

Cancellation Policy :

- Before 30 days of the departure date: 20% deduction from the total trek fees. OR the paid amount can be adjusted against any other camp within 1 year from the date of cancellation.
- Between 30 to 20 days of the departure date: 50% deduction from the total trek fees.
- Within 20 days of the departure date: No refund will be provided.

Things to Carry :

- Warm clothes (jackets, fleece jackets)
- Thermal Clothes (top and bottom)
- Wind & Waterproof jacket
- Two/Three trek pants
- 3-4 t-shirts (Full sleeved, collared/dri-fit)
- Normal Hat/Cap, Woollen Cap, Bandana
- Water proof hand gloves & Woollen Hand gloves
- Socks (4-5 pairs) and a 2 pairs of woollen socks
- Trekking shoes: Carry water proof trekking shoes.
- Sandle / floaters
- Back pack & Rain cover
- Day pack & Rain cover (If hire a mule or porter)
- Hand and Body Warmers, Dark Sunglasses
- Head Lamp with Extra batteries
- Water bottle (1 ltr x 2 nos, insulated type recommended)
- Raincoat / Ponchos
- Sunscreen Lotion & Moisturizer
- Toilet Paper & Wipes
- Snacks – Energy bar, dry fruits, electoral
- Original and photocopy of government photo identity card
- Personal Medicines

Inclusions :

- Local Travel Chandigarh to Janglikh and Back
- Accommodation (Home stay & Hotel)
- Meals (all during trek)
- Professional guide
- Forest permit

Exclusions :

- Food during transit
- Cost of Emergency
- Personal Porter Charges
- Bottled water
- Any personal expense

Note:

01. Alcohol, smoking and chewing pan masala is strictly prohibited.
02. No refund will be made against cancellation.
03. Do not bring any valuable to the camp. Binoculars and cameras to be brought at owners risk.
04. Electric / Mobile / electronic entertainment gadgets are not encouraged.
05. Medical facility in the form of first-aid will be available and best care of the participants will be taken.
06. If you have a history of any communicable or infectious disease, please mention. Medical certificate is compulsory. Personal Insurance not include.
07. The activities listed above are subjected to change.
08. It will be the personal responsibility of the participants to take care of their belongings.
09. No refund will be given in case the camp gets cancelled due to any unforeseen circumstances, act of God or force majeure. The amount will be adjusted in any other camp of wilderness India and can be used in 2 years from the date of cancelled camp.
