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The Valley of Flowers is one of the most beautiful and mesmerizing national parks of the country, situated at an altitude of 3658 m in Bhyundar valley in Chamoli district of Uttarakhand. It is famous for its wide variety of flora (Alpine flowers, Vajradanti, Marsh Marigold, Shomalap, etc) Valley of flowers is a part of Nanda Devi Biosphere Zone with thick green forests, rivers, waterfalls and a wide variety of flora & fauna. Valley of flowers has also been declared as the WORLD HERITAGE SITE by UNESCO.

The trek goes through the dense forest and follows Pushpawati river. On the way you will encounter many waterfalls, bridges and small water streams. The best time to visit Valley of flowers is from Mid-June to Mid September. There are about 520 species of alpine plants and of which 498 are flowering plants. The beauty of the valley can not be captured by the camera, it can only be captured by the eyes and stored in your mind.

Hemkund Sahib - a sacred Sikh pilgrimage nestled amidst the stunning Himalayan peaks is renowned for its serene beauty and spiritual significance. Situated at an altitude of over 4,329 m, this picturesque destination is marked by a shimmering glacial lake surrounded by seven snow-capped mountains.

This is a favourite trekking destination for flower lovers, wildlife lovers, photographers, botanist, bird watchers and nature lovers.



HEMKUND SAHIB

World's highest Gurudwara

Date : 16th - 25th Aug 2026

Grade : Moderate level

Max Altitude : 14,200 Ft.

Fees : ₹ 12,800 only (Rishikesh to Rihikesh)

₹ 19,000 only (Surat to Surat)

Program Itinerary :

- Day 01 Departure from Surat by 3 AC to Haridwar
- Day 02 Reach Haridwar, Drive to Joshimath (250 kms, 10 hrs approx)
- Day 03 Joshimath to Pulna - Starting poin of trek (22 kms, 1 hr drive)
trek to Ghangaria 10500ft. (9 kms, 5 hrs trek approx)
- Day 04 Ghangaria to valley of flower 12000ft., explore valley which is 6-7 km stretches at the ending point with a glacier & back to Ghangaria (10 kms, 7 hrs approx)
- Day 05 Ghangaria to Hemkund Sahib 14200ft., Which is the world's highest Gurudwara and visit the Hemkund sahib Sarovar as well & back to Ghangaria (12 kms, 9 hrs approx)
- Day 06 Ghangaria to Pulna (9 kms, 5 hrs Trek approx) and Drive to Joshimath (22 kms, 1 hr drive)
- Day 07 Joshimath to Rishikesh (250 kms drive, 8 hrs approx)
- Day 08 Full day in Rishikesh- Explore Local Market, Ghats, Ashram & Ganga Aarti
- Day 09 Early morning depart to Rishikesh railway station & return 3AC Train to Surat
- Day 10 Reach Surat with lifelong memories.

Note:

1. Alcohol, smoking and chewing pan masala is strictly prohibited.
2. It will be the personal responsibility of the participants to take care of their belongings.
3. Do not bring any valuable to the camp. Mobil / Cameras to be brought at owners risk.
4. Electric / Mobile / electronic entertainment gadgets are not encouraged.
5. First-aid will be available and best care of the participants will be taken.
6. If you have a history of any communicable or infectious disease, please mention.
7. No refund will be given in case the camp gets cancelled due to any unforeseen circumstances, act of God or force majeure. In this case, the paid amount can be adjusted against any other camp within 1 year from the date of cancellation.
8. The activities listed above are subjected to change.

Cancellation Policy :

- Before 30 days of the departure date: 20% deduction from the total trek fees. OR the paid amount can be adjusted against any other camp within 1 year from the date of cancellation.
- Between 30 to 20 days of the departure date: 50% deduction from the total trek fees.
- Within 20 days of the departure date: No refund will be provided.

- Gloves, Socks (4-5 pairs) and 1pair of woolen socks
- Trekking shoes: Carry water proof trekking shoes
- Sandle / floaters
- Main Rucksack with rain cover (50-60 Ltr)
- 20-30 Ltr Back pack & Rain cover
- Lunch box with spoon
- Dark Sunglasses
- Head Lamp with Extra batteries
- Water bottle (disposable not allowed)
- Raincoat / Poncho
- Sunscreen Lotion & Moisturizer
- Toilet Paper & Wipes
- Snacks – Energy bar, dry fruits, electral
- Original and photocopy of government photo identity card
- Personal Medicines

- Local Travel Haridwar to Joshimath and back
- Accommodation (3-4 Sharing in Hotel)
- All Meals from Joshimath & Breakfast in Rishikesh
- Professional guide
- Forest permit
